Researchers will ask certain designed open-ended questions during the focus group discussion on their self-perceptions over academic, social and cultural knowledge gained from each other and to what extent they have developed connectedness between each other at the end of semester fall, 2015. Evidence Analysis: The evidence gathered from focus group interviews will be analyzed by looking for the themes of the effect of Global Connect program on the connectedness of international students with their American partners. Responses from American students will be used to criticize the self-perception of international students. Quantitative Measure Study Participants: All international students and their American partners in Global Connect program will be studied. Participants can be identified from applications and partners matching within Global Connect program. A sample will not be used. Evidence Collection: All international students and their American partners in Global Connect program will keep track their meeting logs with the total hours they spent
